

**THE ST LEONARDS NATIONAL JUNIOR  
GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP**

**ENTRY FORM**

**Regulations**

- a) The number of entries shall be limited to One hundred and ninety two. Competitors are registered in order of entry. All unsuccessful entrants will be informed without delay thereafter and their entry fees refunded.
- b) Competitors shall enter on the official entry form. Forms are obtainable on application.
- c) The Director of Golf, Rosie Dawson, must receive completed entry forms, accompanied by the entry fee, by 12 noon on the date on which entries close. Late entries will not be accepted.
- d) Competitors wishing to play a Practice round must contact The Links on **01334 466666** to book a Tee Time 2 weeks in advance – if you do not do this then you can only book the day before play
- e) All competitors must register **in person** at the Eden Clubhouse on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> April, at least 30 minutes before their TEE TIME. **U11, U13 + U15** competitors must **produce a current handicap certificate** when registering.
- f) **Competitors without a handicap, or those who fail to meet the competition standard – Girls 36 and Boys 28** will only be permitted to play on **The Balgove**.
- g) Any disputes shall be settled by the Committee, whose decision shall be final.

**Conditions**

- a) The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Local rules as laid down by the Committee.
- b) It will be obligatory for all competitors to play with a ball, which is named on the current R & A or USGA list of Conforming Golf Balls. Copies of this list will be available on site.
- c) **No trolley pullers or caddies allowed.** If during the Championship a player becomes injured, the Committee may, in exceptional circumstances, appoint a trolley puller.  
**Parents/Guardians/relatives may not walk on the fairways or speak to the competitors during play.** Competitors shall walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permitted to ride by the Committee. Penalty – two strokes for each hole at which the breach occurred; maximum penalty per round; four strokes.
- d) One round of **stroke play** shall be played. The individual winners shall be the competitors with the **lowest nett score** in each age group. In the event of a tie the Championship shall be shared. **Scratch prizes** will be awarded. To be eligible for the **Team Prize a School or Club** must enter a competitor into each **Age Group**.
- e) Competitors shall start in the groups and at the times laid down by the Committee. Penalty for breach – disqualification
- f) The Committee reserves the right to make any changes to starting times or the method of play which may become necessary in order to overcome difficulty arising during the playing of the Championship and to ensure as equitable as possible a result.

**Trophies shall be presented to the winner of each age group**
